



What to do when faced with criminal or civil Fraud allegations from a Federal or State Government Agency or Insurance Carrier:

- ✓ DO NOT communicate directly with representatives of government agencies or any other investigators or auditors, without FIRST contacting The Beinhaker Law Firm.
- ✓ DO NOT respond to any subpoena or demand for documents you may receive without FIRST contacting The Beinhaker Law Firm. The firm may be able to challenge that subpoena.
- ✓ DO NOT permit any government agent or insurance carrier auditor to conduct an inspection of your office or records without FIRST contacting The Beinhaker Law Firm.
- ✓ If a law enforcement officer, special agent, investigator or detective has a valid SEARCH WARRANT, you MUST comply with the warrant, but you should contact our office immediately. The search warrant is presumed valid, but can be later challenged in Court; and, if successful, the fruits of the search warrant can be suppressed on a motion, filed by us. DO NOT CONSENT TO A SEARCH OR TURN OVER ANY DOCUMENTS, COMPUTERS, FILES, ETC., UNLESS YOU ARE SHOWN A SEARCH WARRANT SIGNED BY A JUDGE OR MAGISTRATE.

If Law Enforcement Officers or Civil Investigators Come to Your Office Hand Them This Card in a Cordial Manner

“Be informed that I am represented by The Beinhaker Law Firm and I hereby assert all rights to counsel. As such, you are hereby directed to pose NO questions, make NO statements, and/or have NO interaction with me without the presence and/or prior written consent of my attorneys. An inspection of this office shall be conducted at a mutually agreeable time by appointment only made with our attorney named below. Failure to abide by these instructions, provided by my legal counsel, will render any statements made or information obtained inadmissible.”
